The Workshop on Fixed Point Theory 1997, organized by the Institute of Mathematics of Maria Curie-Skłodowska University, Lublin, was held in Kazimierz Dolny, Poland, 23-28 June 1997. The purpose of the workshop was to maintain the tradition of meetings on fixed point theory, previously held in Marseilles (1989), Halifax (1991) and Seville (1995), and to bring together specialists and young researchers interested in various aspects of metric and topological fixed point theory.

There were three mini-courses and several one-hour plenary lectures delivered by invited guest speakers, as well as twenty-minute communications, informal talks, discussions and a problem session. There were altogether fifty four papers and one informal presentation delivered.

The financial support of KBN (Committee of Scientific Research) and the Institute of Mathematics of Maria Curie-Skłodowska University made the meeting possible and enabled mathematicians from different countries to participate (83 participants from 15 countries attended the meeting). The workshop was also sponsored by two banks: PKO BP and BRE.

The success of the meeting was first of all due to the interesting talks delivered by top mathematicians and to a large extent to the excellent conference facilities offered at Kazimierz Dolny.

This volume contains the addresses delivered at the workshop and some papers whose authors had planned to give a talk but couldn't attend the Workshop for various reasons.
